General Recommendations

- **Use always products free of contaminants**
- **Avoid non-specifics or corrosive products**
- **Avoid sun exposition and heavy contact to rougher surfaces**
- **Use cupholders**
- **Avoid contact to extreme temperatures**

Upholstery

General Keeping

- Avoid sun exposition and heavy contact to rougher surfaces
- Clean the leathers periodically,
- In case of stain, remove it fast to avoid changes of tones on the leathers.
- Use neutral soap to clean vinyl surfaces
- Avoid non-specifics or corrosive products
- Certain kind of clothing could migrate colour pigments to the leathers under several conditions like humidity or high temperatures

Conservation & Ceaning

- Avoid dust accumulation on the leathers, use a wet rag to clean it and follow the lode of the wood.
- Use a dry rag to dry the surface after the first step.

We recommend to use non corrosive products, with low % of alcohol. Pencil stains can be removed with pencil eraser
Lime stains can be removed with vinegar

Metal

Conservation & Cleaning

- Use a wet rag with neutral soap, or specialized products for metal products
- We recommend microfiber rag
- Subsequently, dry the surface with a dry rag
- Please remove immediately the plastic protector of the stainless steel furniture, overtime the plastic will break and dust accumulation could be damage the steel
- Clean regularly. it is easier to remove fresh stains than dried stains.
- Use specific products for stainless steel.
- Follow the polish direction (in case it have it) do not use rough metallic rags.
- Do not use corrosive products
